Chemax, Mexico with Hands and Feet Ministries

June 5-11, 2016

(for students who have completed grades 9-12)

2016 will mark the third trip Dauphin Way students have taken to Chemax. Chemax is in the Mexican state of the Yucatan, located about 60 miles inland of Tulum. Tulum is a small waterfront community that is recently growing due to tourism, yet it is still relatively unknown. Our group will fly in to Cancun, stay at a hotel near Tulum, and work in the small Mayan village of Chemax. In Chemax, our group will have the opportunity to work with local builders and families to help build a community center that is appropriate to the Mayan culture and climate. We will also plan and implement a backyard Bible school for local children. We will end each day with dinner and worship. One free day is planned for fun and relaxation as well.
