
Israelite History

- Global History
 - Late Bronze Age Iron I
 - ✤ 1430 1020 BCE
- Authorship Dating *
 - ✤ 7th or 6th century B.C.E.

- God gave rest from all enemies


Tribes fought independently Much of land not taken

The Cycle of Sin






