Summer is a season of welcome. This is the time when our city is most likely to receive new residents, and for many churches, it is the time when those new residents make their first, cautious visits to a congregation and wonder to themselves, "Could this be home?"

At Dauphin Way, we have other "welcomes" to give as well. This summer has been a season of baptisms as families can travel and gather for the first time in a long while – with each baptism we are welcoming someone new into the family of God. During VBS this month, we will welcome children from all around so that they can experience the good news that God welcomes them, too.

And I hope everyone will join me in giving a very special welcome to **Karen Smith, our new Director of Servant Ministries**. Karen is already part of our church family, but she is entering into a new and exciting role as she joins our church staff, and we believe that Dauphin Way will be an even more welcoming presence because of the gifts and graces she brings to our ministry.

As Director of Servant Ministries, Karen's primary goal will be to help anyone — and especially any newcomers — find a place where they can belong and make a difference at Dauphin Way. On Sunday mornings, our welcome starts with our ushers and greeters, and so Karen will oversee the recruiting, equipping, and scheduling of our usher and greeter teams for all our worship services. She will also participate in Dauphin Way 101 alongside our pastors, to help everyone who attends find a group or team where they can grow and flourish. To make sure she knows all the places a person might serve, Karen will be collaborating regularly with our leaders in Meals on Wheels, Family Promise, the Society of St. Stephen, Joy for Johnny, and other serving ministries so that she can ensure they have everything they need — including volunteers —to accomplish their mission. Karen will also be our staff liaison to our ministry partners outside the church (e.g., L'Arche, Mobile Jail Ministry, Dumas Wesley, the Mobile Inner City Mission, and others) so that anyone who wants to serve beyond our church walls has a simple path to do so.

Karen comes to this position with tremendous experience, having served for five years as the Director of Lay Involvement at Trinity UMC, a large membership congregation in Birmingham. Before she began her ministry at Trinity, Karen previously worked as Director of Development for Children's Hospital in Birmingham and as Advancement Officer for the University of Alabama Law School. Karen and her family moved here in 2019 when her husband, Steve Smith, President & CEO of 22nd State Bank, moved their executive headquarters to downtown Mobile. I am so glad that Karen, Steve, Clem (rising 7th grader), and Lilli Margaret (rising 4th grader) found a warm welcome at Dauphin Way, and I am ecstatic to see all the ways that Karen will help all of us extend that welcome even further. **Welcome, Karen!**

In other news, this month's Dauphin Way Journal is much abbreviated, partly because our staff leaders are busy doing their part to extend a Dauphin Way welcome to all. Because our Church Council does not meet in June, I asked our staff to devote their writing time to a new project, instead of their usual monthly reports. This fall, we will be publishing the *Dauphin Way Guidebook*, a yearly overview of all the ways that we at Dauphin Way pray, connect, give, serve, and witness together. We hope that this resource will help anyone and everyone take the next step in growing as a disciple, and we will also be using it as the basis for yearly updates to our website, and even a Dauphin Way app.

Someone once summarized the second general rule of the early Methodist societies this way:

"Do all the good you can; By all the means you can; In all the ways you can, In all the places you can; At all the times you can, To all the people you can, As long as ever you can."

That is the kind of welcome we are here to offer. With every personal touch, every piece of information, every connection, every word, and every action, we welcome everyone — by any means we can — to join us in walking the way of discipleship.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

STAFF-PARISH RELATIONS

After receiving updates from Rev. Michael and Cindy on several financial issues, Michael shared that Karen Smith, who is to begin work on July 1, had attended the recent off-site meeting of the staff at Wilson Newell's house. Ms. Smith quickly meshed with those staff members who were present and participated well in the discussions that occurred. Everyone is excited to have Karen on board and believes that she will be a wonderful addition to the staff.

TRUSTEES

The church ended May in a negative financial position. In May, we paid many of the 2021 Community Care financial commitments in advance of Kathy Jorgensen's retirement. This contributed to the deficit. CDC was positive financially for May and came current with all payments to the church.

The trustees continue to investigate and address roof leaks under the Cloister and in Kathy Jorgensen's office, as well as continuing with repairs, maintenance, and improvements under the Capital Maintenance Plan. Trustees voted to accept a donation of a couch to be used in McGowin Hall as part of the effort to better use the space for fellowship.

FINANCE

Dauphin Way had total receipts of \$148,899, total disbursements of \$161,247 ending the month with a negative balance of \$12,347. Current pledges are up slightly for the year, but non pledged contributions are lagging. Operating Reserve on our balance sheet is the money Cindy transferred from the Operating Money Market account to be invested with the AWFUMF. CDC was positive financially for May with a surplus of \$21,292 and came current with all payments to the church. Several unexpected maintenance expenses occurred during the month (broken ice maker, cooler, and water heater). A motion was made and approved unanimously for said expenses to be paid out of the grant designated fund. The Americana Concert raised \$2,548 for Toulminville-Warren Street UMC's roof damages.
