

Volunteer Role: NEW MEMBER MENTOR

Purpose:

How does this position "make disciples who make a difference"?

To help new members get plugged into the life of the congregation.

Key Responsibilities:

- INVITE Invite them to your Bible Study, Sunday School class, lunch after worship, or for dinner at your house. Invite them to special church events
- INTRODUCE Introduce them to your friends, to people in your small group, Bible study, supper club, or Sunday school class. Introduce them to people with whom you volunteer.
- ENCOURAGE Encourage them to join a Bible study or Sunday school class, to attend the New Member Dessert Party, and to volunteer.

Requirements:

- A willingness to help new members feel welcomed and connected.
- You don't have to have all the answers, just be willing to help the new members find answers to questions they have about the church.
- We need all different types of people to serve as New Member Mentors, because we have all different kinds of new members that join the church.
- We will try to align you with someone that you have a natural connection point with i.e. You have kids around the same age, do the same type of work, grew up in the same area of the country, etc.

Time Commitment:

Serve with 1-2 families a year. This work is done at times that are convenient for you and the person/family you are mentoring.
